Duration: 2h 30min


ITINERARY:






Lisbon Sintra, Cascais, Estoril half day tour

ITINERARY:



Major Sights: Fátima, Óbidos, Batalha,



Evora – Wine Tour Full Day









Duration: 10h

ITINERARY:

We embark on a one-day voyage through the city of Évora – UNESCO World Heritage –. Here, wander the narrow streets and take the time to savour masterpieces of past eras and the key monuments of Évora: the Roman Temple of Diana, the Romanesque-Gothic Cathedral, the Church of São Francisco and its Chapel of Bones as well as the University.

Furthermore, take the opportunity to engage and experience the depth and breadth in the ingredients for some of the most defining dishes in the Portuguese gastronomic range. Following lunch, in the afternoon, we set off in direction of **Azeitão.** Here, we visit one of the most historical and important wine cellars in the country. Following this, we get to taste the traditional Setúbal muscatel. At the end of this marvelous day, we make our return to Lisbon.

Duration: 3h 30min

ITINERARY:

Admire the city's main monuments by night. Major Sights: Lisbon Center, Panoramic view of Jeronimo's monastery and Belem Tower.
